Safeguarding ...

At Cullybackey College our priority is to ensure pupils feel safe and protected. Safeguarding refers to what every member of staff does to ensure you feel safe and protected.



All staff in the College are trained in Child Protection / Safeguarding. Any member of staff you speak with will always try to help you with your problems, worries or fears.
